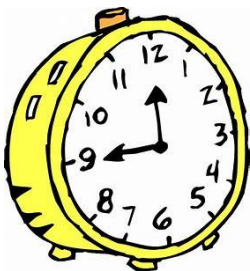

MUTFORD NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

UPDATE

The Mutford Plan will provide a community-led framework for development in the parish through to 2036.

Once completed, it will become part of the local development plan, with Waveney District Council's Local Plan, and will be a statutory consideration in determining all planning applications in the parish.

In September, several members of the working group visited the Neighbourhood Plan team in Wenhaston, a village near Southwold, to discuss their experience and get advice.

The Parish Council will discuss the draft Mutford Plan later this year. Once approved, every household will receive a copy and be invited to make comments. This feedback will then be used to prepare a final version.

A local referendum will be held by Waveney District Council in 2019 for the villagers to decide whether they want to adopt the Plan.

RECYCLING CENTRE (AKA 'Council tip')

Nearest Council-run site is Hadenham Road, South Lowestoft Industrial Estate, Lowestoft, Suffolk, NR33 7NF

(off Tower Road, via London Road-A12. Road opposite Screwfix)

During the winter months (October – March) the recycling centre is open:

9am – 4pm every day except Wednesday

There is no charge for household waste: large non-recyclable items (e.g. mattresses, sofas etc) & excess rubbish bin waste can be taken to the Recycling Centres and placed in the non-recyclable container. There is a charge for soil, rubble, hardcore & plasterboard.



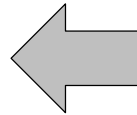

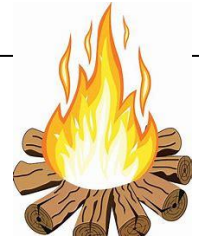
