How to save water...

- Use a bowl in the sink when washing fruit, vegetables or dishes. You can then use the waste water to water your plants.
- Fill a jug of water and put it in the fridge for when you want a cool drink.
- Turn off the tap when you clean your teeth.
 A running tap uses up to 9 litres of water a minute.
- If possible, take a shower instead of a bath.
 A five-minute shower uses about 40 litres of water; this is about half the volume of a standard bath.

Get vaccinated – a new autumn booster programme for people aged over 75, and those who are particularly vulnerable and at risk of serious illness, will start in early September.


